

**Documentation requirements for seed shipped to USA
Effective January 22, 2002**

ALL lots, FSA listed, unless noted below. (Agricultural and vegetable crop kinds listed in US Federal Seed Act.)	PPQ 925	CFIA 5289
ALL lots, FSA not listed, unless noted below. (All kinds not listed in US Federal Seed Act (flowers, trees, herbs etc.)	CFIA 5289	CFIA 5289
Small lots in mail and express courier , FSA listed. (Agricultural and vegetable crop kinds listed in US Federal Seed Act.)	Exempt until October 22	Exempt until October 22
Small lots in mail and express courier , FSA not listed. (All kinds not listed in US Federal Seed Act (flowers, trees, herbs etc.)	Exempt until October 22	Exempt until October 22
Truck loads of small lots prepared for mail distribution within the USA.*	Exempt until Oct 22*	CFIA 5289
Experimental / Breeding lots, FSA listed. (Agricultural and vegetable crop kinds listed in US Federal Seed Act.*)	Less than the amount listed under FSA, Exempt until Oct 22.*	CFIA 5289
Experimental / Breeding lots, FSA not listed, documented as experimental / Breeding. (All kinds not listed in US Federal Seed Act (flowers, trees, herbs etc.)	Exempt until Oct 22*	CFIA 5289

*** Federal Seed Act requirements still apply to Canadian or US origin agricultural or vegetable seed where the lot size is sufficient to require PPQ 925.**

Note: Phytosanitary certificates are also an acceptable option for all of the above
