

**Canadian Seed Trade Association
Arbitration Fees
April 2007**

1. A non-refundable initial filing fee is payable in full, by the filing party when a claim, counterclaim or additional claim is filed.

CSTA Member	\$500.00
Non-Member	\$4,000.00

2. A deposit of the equivalent of SFr.5,000 in Canadian currency is required when the request is filed with CSTA.

After the arbitrators review the case, this deposit may be fixed at a higher amount that must be paid within the time mentioned in the notification of the increased amount. The following expenses will be deducted from the deposit:

CSTA administration fees of \$200.00 per hour plus out-of-pocket expenses.

Arbitrator fees of \$500.00 per day plus expenses.

The arbitration costs shall generally be for the account of the party declared in default. However, the arbitrators, at their discretion, may apportion the arbitration costs between the two parties. If the party who is declared in default has, before the first hearing, offered the other party in writing an amount which is equal to or higher than the amount awarded by the arbitrators, increased by the amount due for arbitration expenses, the costs of the arbitration shall be charged to the other party.
